It's clear from the lineup that the upstate company's new artistic and general director, Lawrence Edelson, was given a mandate to shake things up. Expanded to three and a half weeks, the festival kicks off at the Spa Little Theatre with a display of its traditional opera chops with Rossini's "La Cenerentola," starring Sandra Piques Eddy; continues nearby at the National Museum of Dance, where the legendary director and choreographer Karole Armitage takes Purcell's little masterpiece "Dido and Aeneas" for a spin; and returns to the Spa for the company's first world première in twenty-seven years, Jeremy Howard Beck and Stephanie Fleischmann's "The Long Walk," based on the book by Brian Castner about a soldier's return from the Iraq War.
